Under the 1993 Federal Tax Reform Act, individuals who belong to a notfor-profit Association may not deduct for income tax purposes the portion of their membership dues that is spent on federal or state lobbying activities. Further, membership dues are not deductible as charitable contributions, but may be deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense subject to restrictions imposed as a result of association lobbying activities.

For 2020 dues of \$150 per member, NAR computes 38 percent or \$57 to be nondeductible for the member's income tax due to NAR lobbying efforts. Note that the entire \$35 assessment related to public awareness qualifies as fully deductible.

For 2020 dues of \$100 per member, NYSAR computes \$20 to be nondeductible for the member's income tax due to NYSAR lobbying efforts.

*Primary members: Your 2020 primary dues bill includes a \$35.00 mandatory assessment by the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) of all REALTOR® and REALTOR®-Associate members to fund a nationwide public awareness campaign that includes TV network and cable ads highlighting the value a REALTOR® brings to a transaction and stressing the importance of using a REALTOR®.
